After an engagement with the Department of Social Services, the ArcelorMittal Foundation embarked on a training venture that will see 20 caregivers enter the employment market in September 2022.

The young caregivers are being trained by Grace Home Based Care, a black female run organisation who work in conjunction with the Social Services Department in Newcastle.

The training, which will take place over a period of three months, incorporates adult care, personal care, transporting adults, wound care, primary health care and blood circulation massages, to name but a few.

This is quite the double-edged sword, with the immediate benefit of the employment of these individuals as well as the relief their work will bring to the families that so desperately need their assistance.
