

Boss of SA steel giant to leave

THE chief executive of ArcelorMittal SA, Nonkululeko Nyembezi-Heita, has resigned after six years at the helm, the steel producer said yesterday, without providing reasons.

Chairman Mpho Makwana said the board would embark on a search for a successor to Nyembezi-Heita, whose resignation takes effect on February 18.

“On behalf of the board of ArcelorMittal SA and the ArcelorMittal group, we express our thanks for her unstinting dedication, guidance as well as her calm and determined leadership,” Makwana said. – I-Net Bridge
