**ARCELORMITTAL SOUTH AFRICA EMPLOYEE TRAGICALLY KILLED IN
SHOOTING INCIDENT IN VANDERBIJLPARK**

ArcelorMittal South Africa can confirm the untimely and tragic death of Peet Snyders, head of ArcelorMittal South Africa's coke making operations, on Wednesday evening, 17 March.

Mr Snyders is survived by his wife and two children. Our sincere condolences and heartfelt sympathies go to his family, friends and colleagues. The company is offering all the necessary support, counselling and assistance to his family during this difficult time.

Mr Snyders died of injuries sustained in a shooting incident in Vanderbijlpark on his way home from work. The circumstances around the shooting are unknown at this stage and the incident is being investigated by the South African Police Services. The company will cooperate fully with the investigation to help the authorities get to the bottom of this crime so that the perpetrators can be brought to book.
