to sign indemnity forms. "We understand that people have been living under these dangeroud conditions for years," said a spokesperson. After removing the asbestos beam, filling is the next step. The focus is mainly on the former-governmental housing.

The company is not roofing the extended parts of houses. Asked where they take the asbestos to, she responded that its going to be totally dismantled. We make sure that asbestos is nowhere to be seen again. Ster received calls within the community demanding the company also assist with the extended houses. People are claiming that they are also part of the community.
